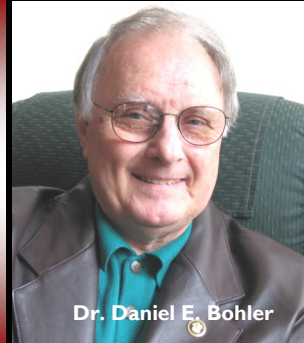

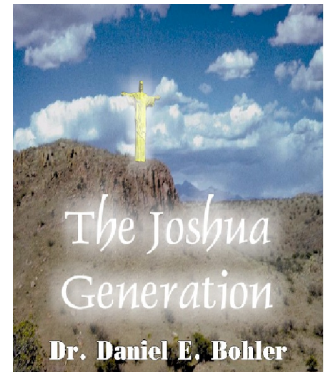
IT IS PART OF GOD'S NATURE AND COVENANT TO PROVIDE FOR
HIS PEOPLE!

God will provide for all the needs of His people because it is part of His nature as well as His Covenant with us to provide for all our needs.

Until we see this revealed in His Word, we will not have the bedrock confidence necessary to rest in Him and trust Him to provide for all our needs in the difficult times ahead. Hard times are here and men's hearts are failing them for fear because of what will begin to happen in the world we live in. (Luke 21:26). (Many of you might not be able to believe the next statement I am making but I know it to be true.) The Christians who are filled with faith, rooted in God's Word and to whom the promises of God are unshakable and sure--they will come through it all and God will meet their needs! In the time of recession and inflation, in difficult times especially, God wants His promises to remain sure, His supply remains stable, and He will continue to meet your need because it is in His nature and Covenant to provide for you, if you believe in Him through Jesus Christ, your Savior!

JEHOVAH-JIREH "THE LORD WHO PROVIDES"

In the Old Testament, God revealed Himself as JEHOVAH-JIREH or "the Lord Who provides." Since God's name revealed His nature, we see that God is a Provider and that it is rooted in His very nature to provide for His people. We also see that God is a Provider because of His many acts of gracious provision in faithfully and abundantly meeting His people's needs throughout the Old and New Testaments. We find the name, JEHOVAH-JIREH, first used when God revealed Himself to Abraham as "the Lord Who provides," when God provided a ram as a substitute offering (on Mount Moriah) for Isaac, Abraham "called the name of that place, JEHOVAH-JIREH (Genesis 22:14)" or "The Lord Who provides." As JEHOVAH-JIREH, God not only furnished Abraham a substitute offering for Isaac, but He also provided a "table in the wilderness" for His people, Israel as they traveled from Egypt toward the Promise Land of Canaan! For 40 years, God sent manna and quail for His people to eat and provided water to quench their thirst. He guided them by the pillar of fire and the pillar of cloud, all the while keeping them in health. What a wonderful Provider He was to His people, and is to us today!!! The God who provided for Israel, materially and spiritually, is the same God we worship today and Who will provide for all our needs as we walk in obedient faith with Him.

Paul told the Philippian Christians, that because they gave so bountifully to the work of God, as God's people, they could expect Him to provide for all their needs according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus! (Philippians 4:19).

“Do not judge, or you too will be judged. For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.” Matthew 7:1.

Too many of us have too little tolerance for others. We judge one another when we ought to be judging ourselves. For example, a man was expressing to a minister his dissatisfaction with the conduct of the greeters in the church he attended. He described the greeters as being cold, unconcerned, and abrupt in their demeanor, hurrying people out the door. He went on at length about the situation, when finally the minister replied.

“We should be careful about judging motives. We cannot know the heart of another individual, and to assume that a person is cold or uncaring because of how they greet us is really unfair.. There may be other circumstances which cause them to seem unconcerned about you in their manner.”

He then encouraged the complainer to try to break the chain, by taking hold of the greeter’s hand in his two hands, and inquiring as to his welfare. For example, he could say, “You seem hurried and distracted. Is everything all right with you? Would you like me to pray with you about something?” This would bring to the attention of the “greeter” the manner in which he was performing his task without offending him; and it would take the complainer’s focus off himself as well.

What a wonderful word of counsel I heard that day. Hopefully, I will not soon forget it, and perhaps may have opportunity to employ it. The minister was right. We cannot judge another’s heart by outward appearance. Jesus said, “*Judge not, or you too will be judged.*” The reason we fall into this error is because we may have a problem tolerating another’s mistake. When people do not act in a way that pleases, or at least suits us, we have little time for them, and so we form a value judgment. We not only judge the actions of others; we judge by appearances. Perhaps they are not dressed right, or their hair is not styled to our liking.

The definition of the word “tolerate” is “*to lift up; to endure, without injurious effect.*” We are hardly lifting up others when we are so quick to criticize or judge their appearance or their actions. The Lord often disguises His will. The prophet Samuel would have chosen Eliab to replace King Saul. He judged him by his outward appearance. But God said, “No, this is not My choice, neither are any of these brothers who are here. Is there not another?”

Young David is out in the pasture, tending sheep. “*Send for him.*” David, all smelly and sweaty came in, an unlikely candidate as a king. But God knew David’s heart. He knew his faults and his weaknesses, but he also knew He could work with them, because David had a heart after God. Look at God’s opinion of David, recorded in Acts 13:22: “*I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after my own heart, which shall fulfill all my will.*” Would you like the Lord to also say this about you?

“*The natural man receives not the things of the spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned (judged). But he that is spiritual judges all things, yet he himself is judged by no man.*” 1 Corinthians 2:14-15.

It is only by the spirit of God that we can begin to spiritually discern another, and then our judgment is fair and scriptural, not petty, mean and self-asserting. Paul states in 1 Corinthians 3:1, “*I could not speak unto you as unto spiritual, but as unto carnal, even as unto babes in Christ.*” The truly spiritual individual looks for the good in others. When indeed there is a real problem, the spiritual man or woman searches for ways to help -- to lift another to a higher realm. The spiritual individual will pray for you, rather than judge you.

Isaiah 53 prophetically describes Jesus as despised and rejected of men, having no beauty that anyone should desire Him. Little did they know that He was the Son of God, the Savior and King for eternity. They judged Him wrongly and mankind has suffered for it. Israel is suffering for it. The sad commentary is that we may be numbered with those who are intolerant of the truth that Jesus brought.

What about our ability to tolerate God’s people today? Are we continually finding fault with others? Jesus warns us to first take care of the problems in our own lives; then we may be able to see clearly to spiritually discern a brother or sister’s problem.

Like the minister in our opening example, we can improved the situations around us; we can lift each other by our Godly concern. Let us become part of the solution rather than part of the problem. This is the way of the Overcomer.

Bibi be gone: Obama team plotting overthrow of Israel's Netanyahu

Washington - The administration of President Barack Obama has launched what officials termed a psychological warfare campaign meant to topple Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu.

Sources in the administration and Congress asserted that the White House and State Department have sought to destabilize Netanyahu's government by forcing him to agree to an indefinite freeze on Jewish construction in the West Bank and most of Jerusalem as well as the establishment of a Palestinian state by 2012. They said the campaign sought to replace Netanyahu with opposition leader and former foreign minister Tsipi Livni. "Bibi is extremely vulnerable to pressure," a source familiar with the White House effort said. "We know this from his first term in office and believe he will collapse this time as well."

The sources said the administration's strategy aimed to de-legitimize Netanyahu in his government and right-wing constituency, Middle East Newline reported. They said Obama and his aides have sought to portray Netanyahu as a weak and unstable politician who will destroy relations with Washington as Israel seeks U.S. support for a military option against Iran. "There seems to be a general belief in the circle around the president that the democratically-elected government in Israel is drunk at the wheel," Steven Rosen, a veteran pro-Israeli lobbyist now with the Middle East Forum, said. "They clearly will use pressure tactics to bring Israel around."

In April 2010, former U.S. ambassador to Israel Martin Indyk began a series of attacks on Netanyahu in the Israeli media. Indyk, a former assistant secretary of state under then-President Bill Clinton, has called for the toppling of Netanyahu while his right-wing partners accept a more pliant prime minister. "Indyk was sent by Obama and encouraged by his American Jewish supporters, particularly (former Rep.) Robert Wexler, to do this," the source said.

In January 2010, Wexler resigned from Congress to become head of the Center for Middle East Peace and Economic Cooperation. The center was founded by Obama supporter Daniel Abraham and a delegation met Netanyahu in February. The sources said the administration's campaign has included invitations to Defense Minister Ehud Barak to the White House, where he met with Obama on April 26. Barak has been regarded as the most pro-U.S. minister in Netanyahu's Cabinet and has been lobbying ministers to accept Obama's proposals.

"It's not going to be easy to turn this thing around." Rosen told a briefing on April 21. "Some of my friends in Jerusalem believe this crisis will go on for an extended period." The anti-Netanyahu fervor has alarmed pro-Israeli members in Congress, particularly from the Democratic Party. Several of the Democrats have reported a sharp drop in funds by Jewish donors for congressional elections in November.

"This (campaign against Netanyahu) is counterproductive and has to stop," Sen. Charles Schumer, a New York Democrat who has threatened to issue a condemnation of the White House, said.

Some in the pro-Israel community detect an anti-Semitic tinge to the White House campaign, despite the involvement of Jewish aides.

Former State Department official Aaron Miller said Obama has surrounded himself with aides who blame Netanyahu for the suspension of the Arab-Israeli peace process. Miller said many of the aides had encountered Netanyahu during his first tenure as prime minister from 1996 to 1999. "They had seen the Benjamin Netanyahu movie before and were determined not to let their chance at Middle East peace end the same way," Miller said in the magazine Foreign Policy. "Confronted with Netanyahu again, Obama and his team needed no encouragement to talk tough on the growing Israeli settlements in the West Bank, an issue that experts inside and outside government were clamoring for Obama to raise as the first step in his renewed push for peace. Fresh from his victory on health care, he's (Obama) king of the world again and in no mood to let the king of Israel frustrate his plans."
